

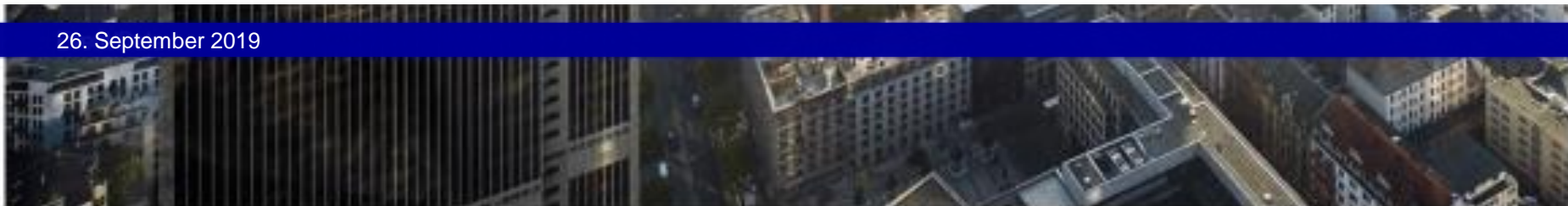

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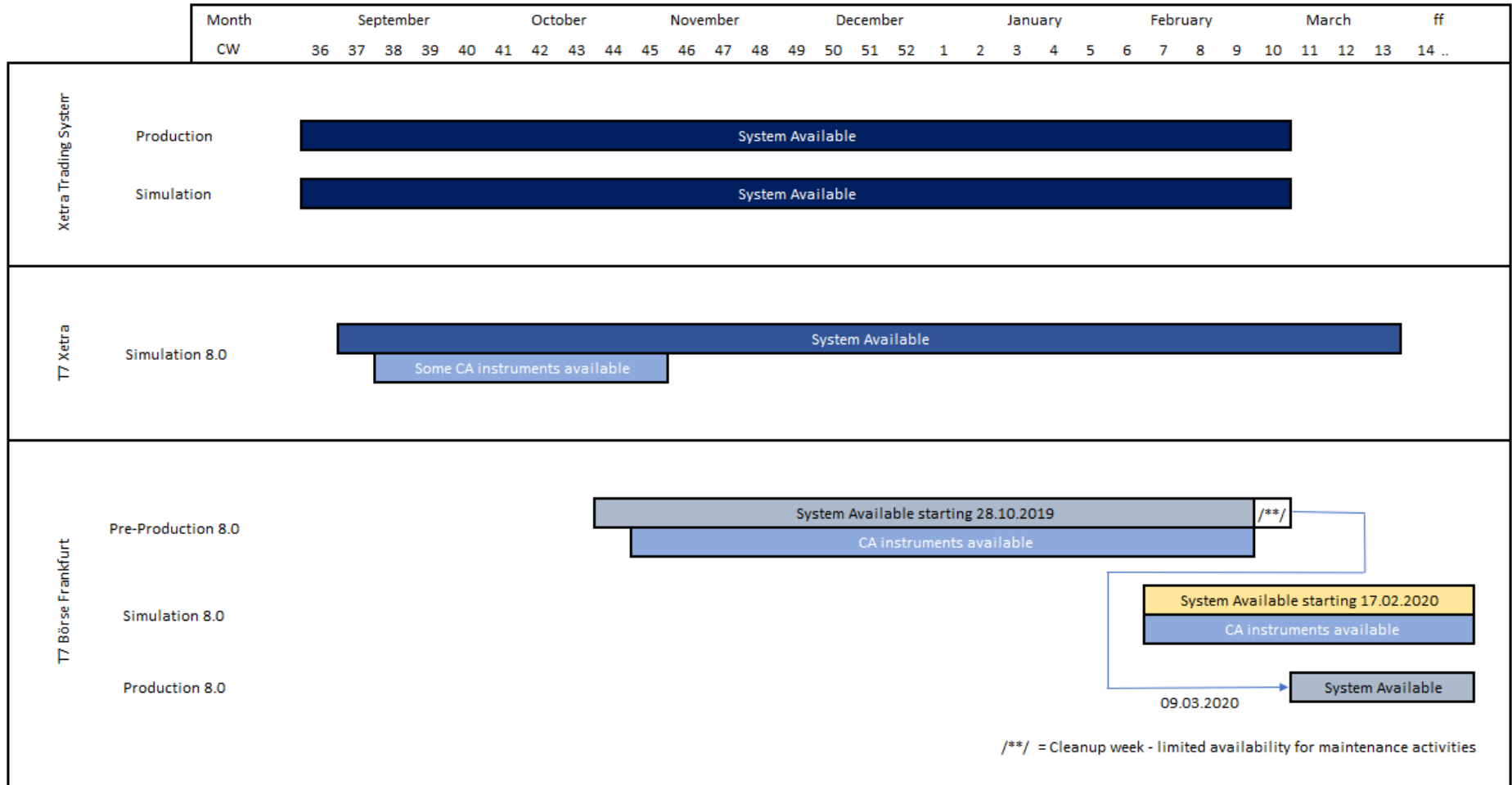
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## Introduction

- With T7<sup>®</sup> Release 8.0, the trading model *Continuous Auction with Specialist (CA-S)* will be introduced in T7 in order to support the complete migration of Börse Frankfurt (BF) including Börse Frankfurt Zertifikate (BFZ) from the Xetra trading system onto the T7 trading platform
- The functionality of the trading model *Continuous Auction with Specialist* on T7 is mainly derived from the functionality in the Xetra trading system
- Deviations exist for harmonisation and optimisation reasons motivated by the creation of synergies, resulting in a consolidated platform with consistent interfaces for T7 Xetra and T7 Börse Frankfurt. Please refer to the *Final Release Notes* and *Functional Reference* for more details
- To ease migration and allow members a long simulation period with the same number of instruments as in production, a dedicated Pre-Production T7 Börse Frankfurt environment will be set up in October.

# Testing possibilities in T7 environments



## Continuous Auction with Specialist in T7 Xetra Simulation

- Approx. 200 CA-S instruments will be offered in T7 Xetra Simulation from 18 September until the beginning of November 2019
  - For BF, instruments will be set up as CCP-eligible and non-CCP eligible
  - For BFZ, instruments will be set up as non-CCP-eligible
- A dedicated internal DBAG member will act as Specialist and enter matching quotes on request for approx. 20 instruments



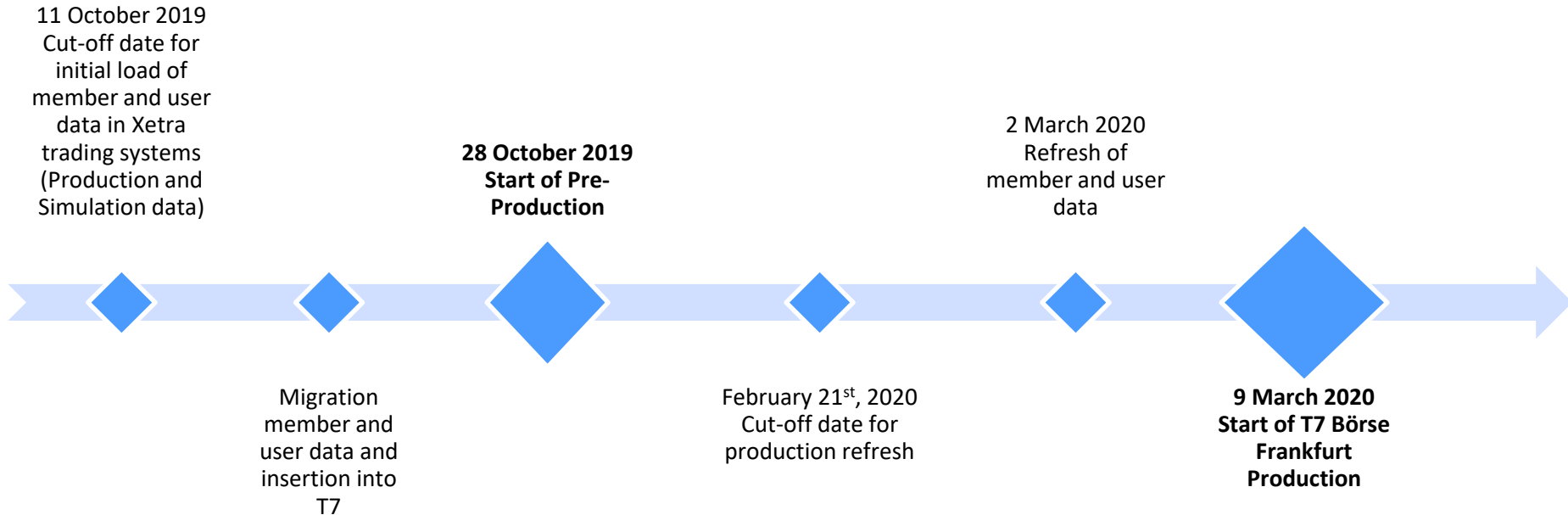

# T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production System Setup

- T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production will be available for testing from 28 October 2019
- T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production will be set up in its own separate environment that will be used for production starting 9 March 2020
  - Members will be required to request new low-frequency and FIX sessions for T7 Börse Frankfurt
  - T7 Börse Frankfurt sessions requested for Pre-Production will be the actual T7 production sessions
  - T7 Börse Frankfurt will have to be accessed by Low-Frequency ETI sessions, FIX sessions or GUIs
- Multicast address configuration for EOBI, MDI, and RDI will be kept for production
- Rollover/Batches
  - T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production will follow the simulation trading calendar and will therefore provide three end-of-day processing runs (batches) per week unless otherwise explicitly stated
  - The batch schedule calendar will be aligned with the corresponding (simulation) systems CCP, T7, and CBF (CASCADE in IMS23)

# T7 Börse Frankfurt

## Member and user data setup



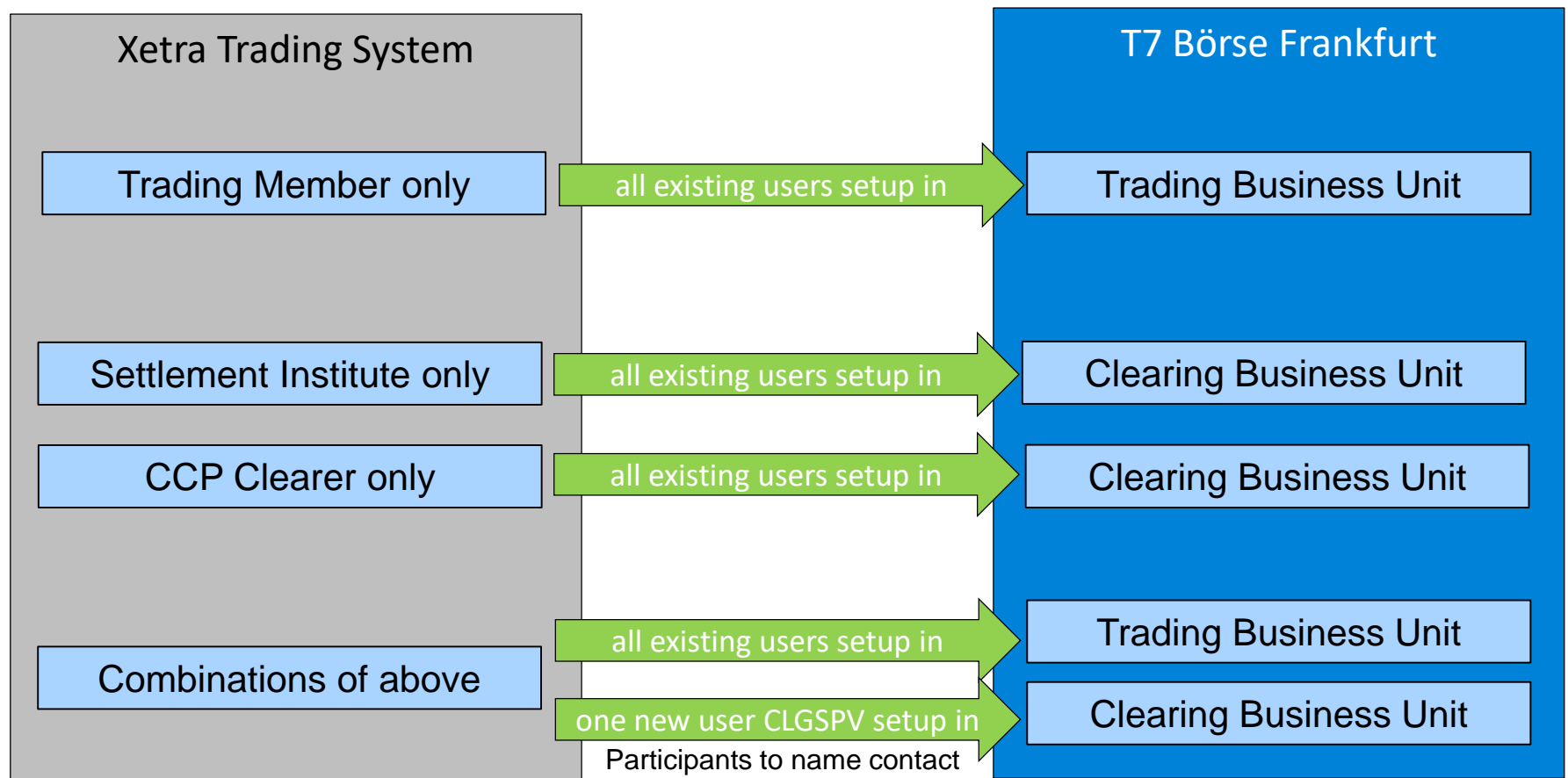
### Exceptions:

- Users that have not changed their password since the introduction of Xetra 13.0 in 2012 will not be migrated. An exception will be, if the user is part of a Specialist or Issuer subgroup that still services an instrument.

Changes to production participant data performed after the cut-off date in February will need to be performed in the Xetra trading production system **and** in T7 Börse Frankfurt.

# Member to Business Unit migration

Depending on member settings, the following business units will be setup in T7






# T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production

## User passwords

- The passwords will be migrated from the Xetra trading system.
- Upon initial GUI login, a user will be requested to insert a new password.

 **Passwords for all users** (regardless of later on accessed interface) **will have to be changed by accessing any T7 GUI once.** Ensure to enter old password in **CAPITAL letters** during initial login and adhere to the new password rules of T7 (refer to Cash Market Participant and User Maintenance Manual - 5.3.3 Password Rules)

# T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production

## Member and user cleanup for production start

- Member and User deletion of
  - Simulation only member and associated users
  - Vendors and associated users
  - Users not setup in the Xetra trading production system
- Refresh of Trading Business Unit Entitlement
  - The following roles on Business Unit level will be aligned according to the RAL setup in the Xetra trading production system
    - CASH TRADER
    - TES TRADER
    - TES BROKER
    - CASH SPECIALIST
- User data will be refreshed. Please note that existing T7 **Usernames, technical Ids and passwords will not be changed**

## T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production Member and user setup – testing suggestions

DBAG suggests to verify set up data during the Pre-Production phase and to keep existing participant, business unit, and user data stable to ensure proper alignment of data at actual production start in relation to setup in the Xetra trading system.

Therefore, the following recommendations are made:

- Keep settings of Participant, Business Unit, and users stable,
- Setup dedicated test users in Pre-Production for testing of
  - Trading Scenarios (e.g. Role Assignment changes and impact on trading, maximum parameters defined on a user level like *Maximum Order Value*, etc)
  - Bilateral Aggregation and Settlement Internalisation

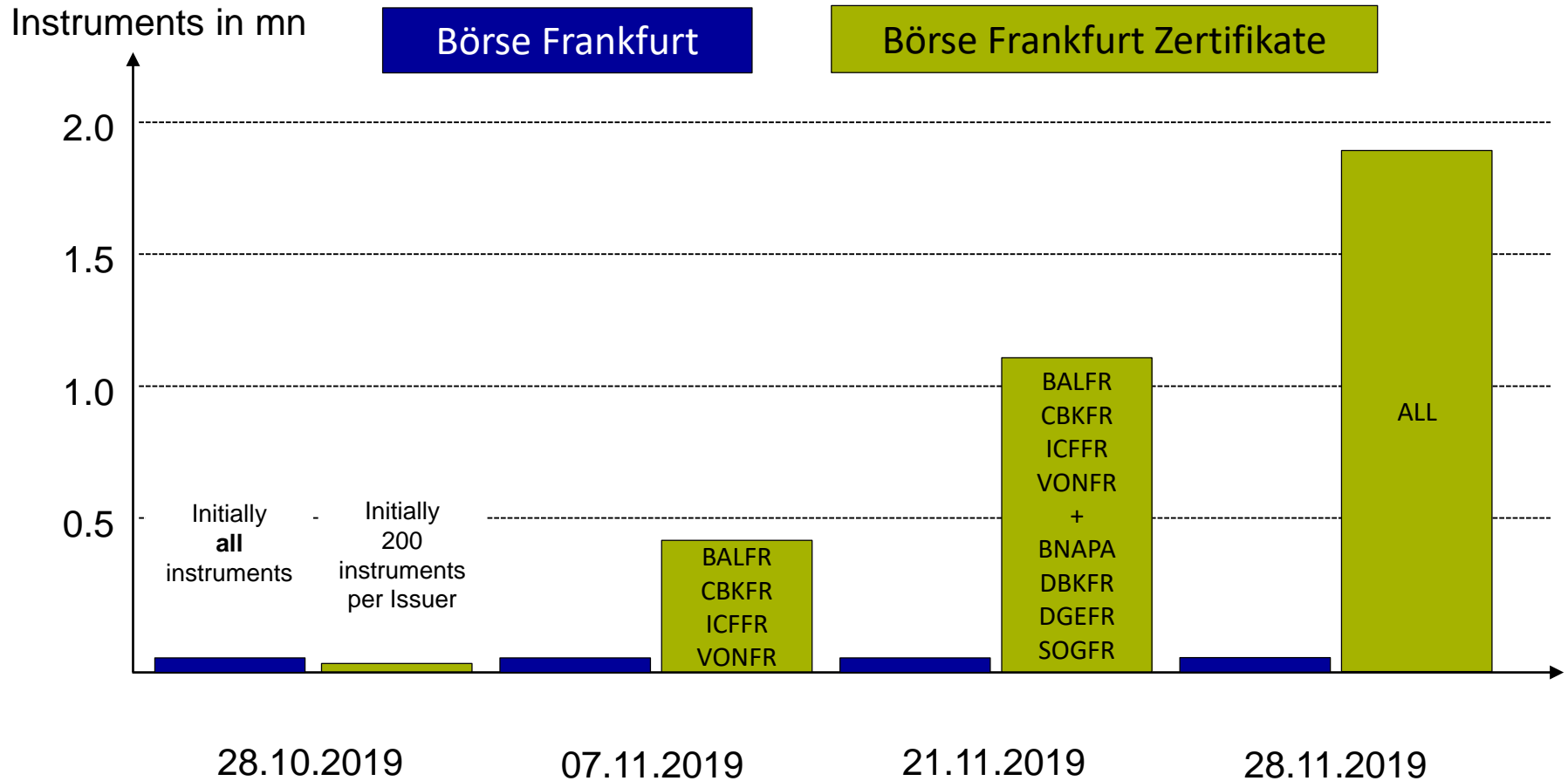
## Instrument Ramp-up in T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production

The term *Instrument Ramp-Up* refers to the instrument load process in T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production until the number of instruments in T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production resembles the number of instruments in the Xetra production trading system

The following guiding principles have been applied:

1. Possibility to test all asset classes early on
2. Possibility to provide at least one instrument to all Specialists in T7 Börse Frankfurt
3. Possibility for issuers to test using their own instruments
4. Possibility for BFZ Specialists to test a full set of instruments of an issuer early on
5. Staggered upload of instrument reference data in packages so customers can better cope with the large number of instruments in the new T7 trading system

## Instrument Ramp-up in T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production

- On ramp-up days, Pre-Production will close at **2 p.m.**
- Instrument updates based on production changes will be applied during each Pre-Production end-of-day processing once the instrument is listed.
  - Please note that the instrument updates will have a delay of at least one day due to the trading calendar used (simulation calendar) and the early simulation-like end-of-day processings of T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production.

Please note that all BFZ instruments listed as bonds on the Xetra Trading System will be listed as warrants on T7 Börse Frankfurt.

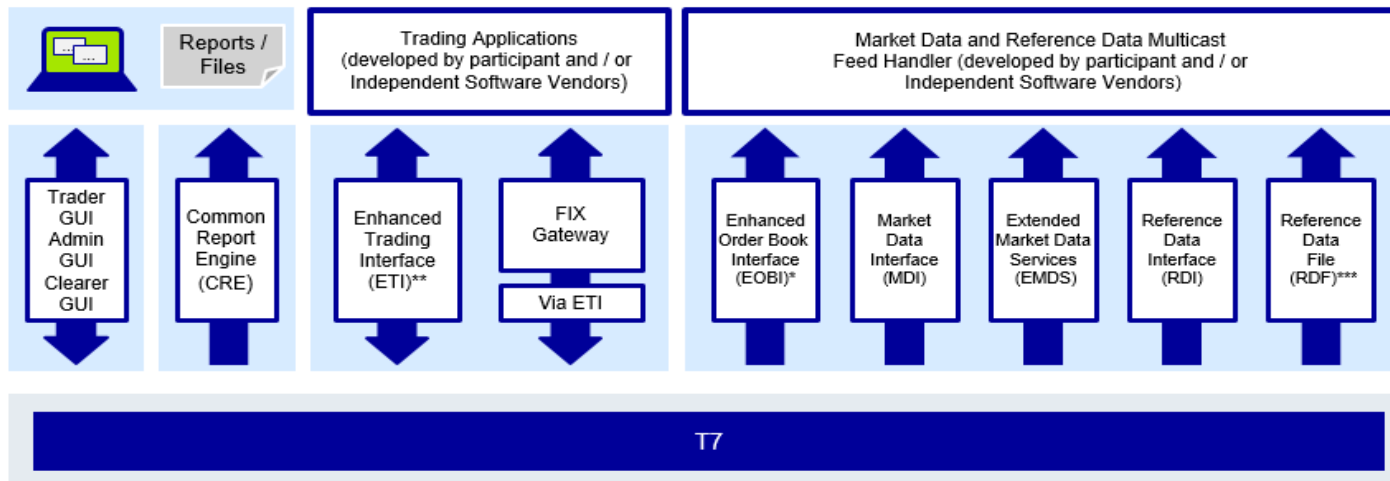
## CA-S in T7 Börse Frankfurt Pre-Production

- Some extra ISINs of CA-S instruments will be offered in addition to the production instruments where an internal DBAG member will be acting as the Specialist (and Issuer).
  - Quoting support will be provided for those ISINs.
  - ISINs will be listed in the Pre-Production Guide
- Knock-outs will not be performed by Market Operations in T7 except on certain dedicated focus days. Otherwise knocked-out instruments will be updated in the end-of-day processing by setting the last trading date

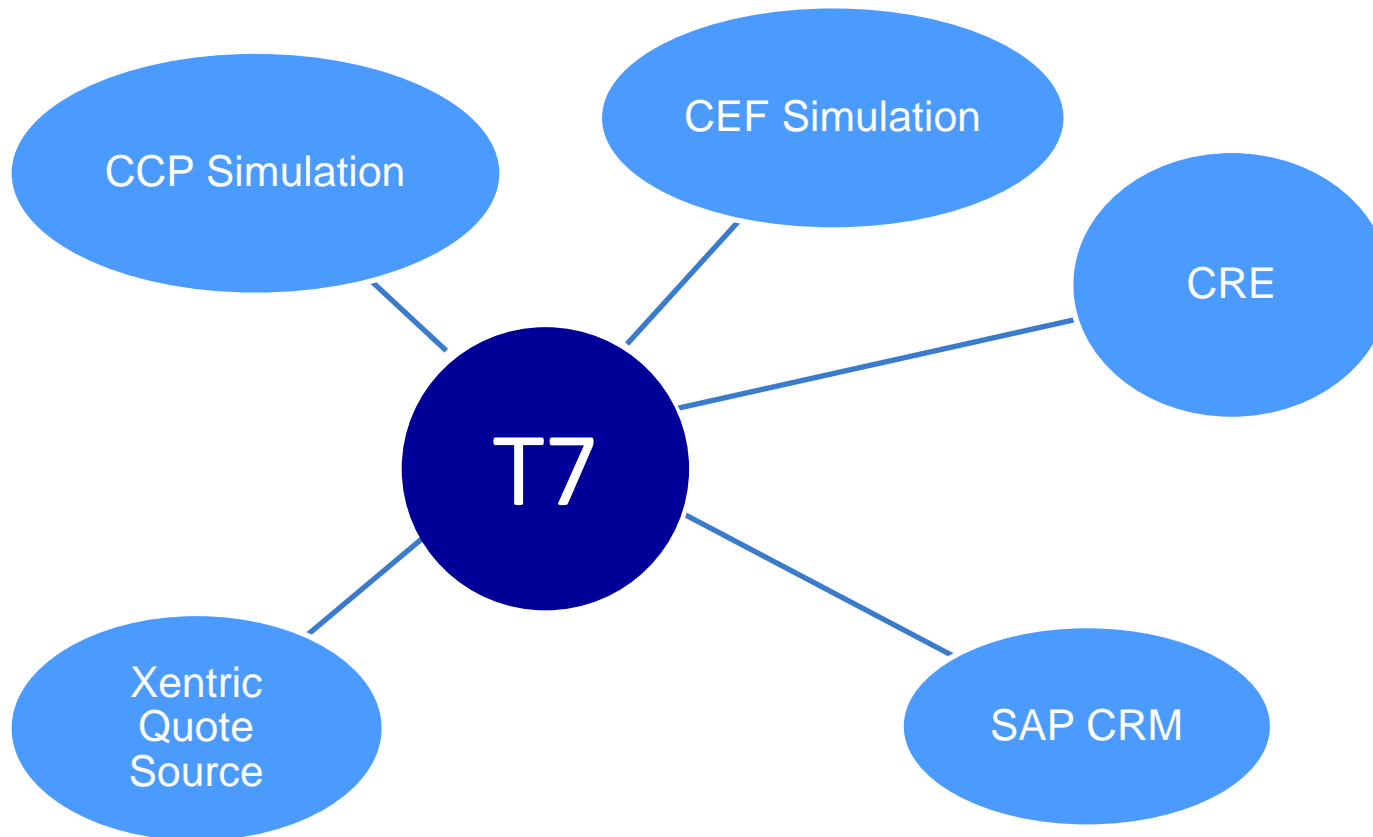

## Member tasks before production launch

- Technical setup can be performed any time before production launch
  - Order dedicated low frequency T7 Börse Frankfurt production sessions for ETI and FIX (which can also be used for Pre-Production)
    - Vendors will get temporary access to test their applications during the Pre-Production phase
  - Change user passwords
- User Setup
  - Verify user roles
  - Ensure password changes of all users prior to production start otherwise no login will be possible

Note: 6 March 2020, existing orders in Xetra production trading system that would have been valid on 9 March 2020, will be deleted. Those orders can be identified by

- FIX Execution Report - *ExecRestatementReason* 6 (Cancel on Trading Halt)
- ETS Trade Notifications – *TrnReasonCode* “SUS” + *trnTim* 23:59:**58.99**
- TC540 Daily Order Maintenance - *rsnOrdrDel* is „SUS“ + *entTim* 23:59:**58**
- VALUES Trade Confirmation - *trnTim* 23:59:**58.99**
